

# Sample and Methodology

This survey was launched on the 1st of October gaining over 36,000 responses from Muslims currently living in the UK within one week. This piece of research contains the largest sample size of Muslims bar the UK 2020 Census. Each participant was interviewed via an online survey.

Results of any sample are subject to sampling variation. The margin of error varies based on the size of the sample. In this particular study, the chances are 95 in 100 that a survey result does not vary, plus or minus, by more than <1% from the result that would be obtained if interviews had been conducted with all persons in the universe represented by the sample.
